

1 Report of the Education AR – 2017

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3 The Immediate Past President shall be responsible for the supervision and direction
4 of the Area of Responsibility-Education. The Dental Education Program shall
5 reside in this area. Also, association matters pertaining to, but not limited to, oral
6 health education shall be in the area of Education.

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8 The Dental Education Program provides Hawaii Dental Association members with
9 quality continuing dental education from internationally recognized speakers at a
10 reasonable cost. Additionally, it provides members the opportunity to visit over 100
11 exhibitors, who share the latest in dental products and services, and feature a full display
12 of state-of-the-art equipment and technology. Program Chair Dr. Jaclyn Lum and
13 program members help to plan, organize, and run The Hawaii Dental Association
14 Convention in January every year. Dr. Lum did an exceptional job her first year as Chair.

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16 The Convention implemented a “Grant Model” starting with the HDA Convention in
17 2017. This \$3,000 grant per speaker allowed program planners the flexibility to select
18 speakers. This format worked very well for us with very positive reviews concerning the
19 quality of speakers. This success should allow more leverage regarding the speakers, the
20 content of the lectures, and recourse in the event the speaker does not comply with their
21 contractual agreement.

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23 2017’s convention included the Women’s Breakfast, Life Member Lunch and our first
24 HDA sponsored ethics course that had over 300 members attending for their required
25 state CE credits. The HDA Young Dentists also held their class within the convention
26 timeframe and we can look forward to similar collaborative efforts in the future.

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28 The 2018 convention is scheduled for Jan. 18 and 19, 2018 with all speakers confirmed.
29 The ADA confirmed for Oct. 18 – 22, 2018 in Hawaii. 2019 January HDA convention
30 will be cancelled and a small CE program is being planned for April 18 and 19, 2019.

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32 The member Life Luncheon is schedule for Thursday at 12 noon and the Women’s
33 Breakfast will be postpone till 2020.

Background: In 2018 the Education AR plans to exercise sound fiscal management and requires appropriate funding to perform its program and task force responsibilities and recommends adoption of the following resolution:

Resolved, that the House of Delegates budget the sum of \$406,400 (income) and \$212,100 (expense) for conduct of the Education AR activities in 2018. These numbers currently do not reflect a decrease in the food and beverage budget: decrease from \$25,000.00 to \$11,000.00, and an additional line item for volunteers’ stipend of \$1,000.00
