12 13 14	The CPHP addressed via Zoom, the COVID-19 request regarding HDA acknowledgement of a specific organization and implied support of this organization's work. The CPHP determined that HDA's name is not to be used in its efforts.
16 17 18 19	The CPHP addressed via Zoom, a service being provided by a third-party dental insurance carrier and a specific Medicaid participant registration in the same context of re-credentialing. This was a positive informational meeting by opening the lines of communication between the carrier and HDA.
21 22 23	The CPHP continues to address concerns about community and public dental health and how these concerns affect the HDA and its members, and to make recommendations in the best interest of the HDA and its members.
