Report of the Dental Benefits Providers Task Force 2019
Strategic Plan Goal #3 – Advocacy: Effectively ensure that the profession of dentistry is protected and maintained at the highest regard, among key decision makers and the people of Hawaii, through strong public policy and advocacy efforts.
The Dental Benefits Providers Task Force, under the direction of the HDA Board of Trustees, has met throughout the year. Members Drs. Neil Nunokawa, Kerry Ishihara, and Dayton Lum, along with ex-officio Executive Director Ms. Kim Nguyen, discussed the formulation of the Task Force and the coordination of activities. Drs. Scott Kanamori and Todd Girard have since joined. The Task Force continues to seek a few more members.
The purpose of the Task Force is to research the policies and the business practices of all the dental benefit providers in Hawaii. The Task Force plans to address the membership concerns with dental benefits and providers, and to provide a forum for issue driven discussions with players within the dental benefit arena.
Activities generated through this Task Force were meetings with the ADA Department of State Government Affairs and the Hawaii State insurance commissioner. A dental benefit survey is currently being designed to seek membership input and feedback. Survey results will inform the specific strategies and activities.
The Task Force sees this work as a longer-term project for the HDA Board then was anticipated, and therefore may evolve into a Program if the progress and activities over the next year require such a transition. Until such time, requests for funding will be through the Board.
