7	The Hawaii Dental Association's status as a trade organization precludes its ability to
8 9	make campaign contributions or engage in political activity. A separate political action committee with its own officers was established and is completely independent of the
10	HDA. This report is advisory only.
11	
12	Activities/Goals:
13	Compliance and capacity building were key initiatives for 2022 and the PAC engaged the
14	bookkeeping and campaign spending commission reporting services of Accumulus.
15	
16	The PAC leaders were aware prior to 2022 that all 76 state legislators and the governor's
17	seat would be up for election in 2022. A decision was made to contribute to candidates
18	aligned with dentistry and promoting oral health prior to start of 2022. Additional
19 20	contributions will likely be made post-primary and in advance of the November 8 elections.
