

1           Report of the HDA John H. Dawe Scholarship Fund – 2022-H

2  
3   **Strategic Plan Goal #2 – Community:** Ensure that the HDA has an active role in  
4 promoting awareness and improving the oral health of the people of Hawaii.

5  
6  
7 As of June 30, 2022, the John H. Dawe Scholarship Fund had a value of \$276,499.47.00.  
8 The investment earnings on this fund were negative (\$39,006.44) as of April 1, 2022.  
9 (Investment earnings include interest and dividends and realized/unrealized gain/(loss) on  
10 investments. This is a substantial loss from 2021.) As of April 1, 2022, the fees & other  
11 expenses were \$989.00.

12  
13 The grant making budget for 2022, available funds, was \$20,569.00 as of June 30, 2022.  
14 A total of \$12,000.00 of grants was awarded in the 2022.-2023 scholarship year. Here is  
15 the breakdown on the scholarship awardees:

17 1.       \$3,000.00 to Kailani Anderson-Hanohano, a freshman at Grand Canyon  
18           University, with a Dental Hygiene major.  
19  
20 2.       \$3,000.00 to Michelle Leung, a senior at the University of Hawaii-Manoa with a  
21           Dental Hygiene major.  
22  
23 3.       \$6,000.00 to Sophia Oak, a third-year graduate student with a Certificate in  
24           Dental Public Health. She is declaring a Dentistry major but is currently not in  
25           dental school.

26  
27 Please note, that the “awards” are determined by a committee selected by the Hawaii  
28 Community Foundation. The Hawaii Dental Association has no input on the selection.  
29 This is an endowed, Hawaii Community Foundation Scholarship Fund. As of 2016, the  
30 total amount granted has been approximately \$103,000.00
