

1 Report of the John H. Dawe Scholarship Fund – 2023

2
3 **Strategic Plan Goal #2 – Community:** Ensure that the HDA has an active role in
4 promoting awareness and improving the oral health of the people of Hawaii.

5
6 As of March 31, 2023, the John H. Dawe Scholarship Fund had a value of \$279,267.41.
7 (Current balance as of August 31, 2023 is \$284,168.00.) NOTE: Official second quarter
8 statements are not available as of time of this report. The investment earnings on this
9 fund were \$15,549.97 as of April 1, 2023. (Investment earnings include interest and
10 dividends and realized/unrealized gain/(loss) on investments.) This is a substantial
11 earnings gain from 2022. As of March 31, 2023, the fees & other expenses were
12 \$1,025.25. Our current cash balance is \$17,545.00. The grant making budget for 2023,
13 available funds, was \$16,577.00 as of March 31, 2023.

15 A total of \$9,000.00 of grants was awarded in the 2022-2023 Scholarship year. Here is
16 the breakdown on the Scholarship Awardees:

18 1. \$3,000.00 to Kailani Anderson-Hanohano, now a sophomore at Grand Canyon
19 University, with a Dental Hygiene major.

21 2. \$6,000.00 to Sophia Oak, currently in a Masters/PhD program at Temple
22 University. Her enrolled major is Dentistry.

24 Please note, that the awards are determined by a committee selected by the Hawaii
25 Community Foundation. The Hawaii Dental Association has no input on the selection.
26 This is an endowed, Hawaii Community Foundation Scholarship Fund. As of 2016, the
27 total amount granted has approximately been \$122,000.00
