

1 Report of the John H. Dawe Scholarship Fund –2019

2
3 **Strategic Plan Goal #2 – Community:** Effectively promote oral health awareness and ensure
4 that the Hawaii Dental Association is recognized as the known authority in dentistry and as
5 having an active role in improving the oral health of the people of Hawaii.

6
7 As of June 30, 2019, the John H. Dawe Scholarship Fund had a value of \$264,762.25. The
8 investment earnings on this fund were \$7,055.94 thru June 30th. (Investment earnings include
9 interest and dividends and realized/unrealized gain/(loss) on investments. The total fees paid
10 to the Hawaii Community Foundation in 2019 was \$887.75. (12mos total approx. \$1,775.50)

11
12 The Grant making budget for 2019, available funds, was 7,419.00. Last year, (2018), the fund
13 granted \$7,000.00 out of a budget of \$9,184.00.

14
15 A total of \$8,000.00 of Grants was awarded in the 2019 Scholarship year as of June 2019. The
16 actual total that will be awarded in 2019 is \$6,000.00. One recipient denied the scholarship.
17 Here is the breakdown on the Scholarship Awardees.

19 1. \$2,000.00 to Christian Cedillos, at Hawaii Community College with a Dental Hygiene
20 major. (This student has declined to accept the scholarship.)
21 2. \$2,000.00 to Chelsey Kahoonei, a senior at University of Hawaii-Maui College with a
22 Dental Hygiene major.
23 3. \$2,000.00 to Mayvic Rose Rivera, a sophomore at the University of Hawaii at Manoa
24 with a Dental Hygiene major.
25 4. \$2,000.00 to KianaMarie Soliven, a sophomore at University of Hawaii at Manoa,
26 with a Dental Hygiene major.

28 It is interesting to note that there were no scholarships granted to dental students this year.

30 This is an Endowed, Hawaii Community Foundation Scholarship Fund. Since inception the
31 total amount granted has been \$76.750.00 (This is an approximation.)
