

1 Report of HDA Administration/Communications – 2021-H

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3 **Strategic Plan Foundation: Administration/Communications**

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6 All Board of Trustees meetings were held via Zoom in 2021, despite hopes that we could  
7 come together for at least one in-person meeting, which would have been the July 8<sup>th</sup>  
8 Board meeting. Instead, the BOT and several program chairs spent that meeting via  
9 Zoom participating in HDA’s Strategic Plan Refresh session, facilitated by Hawaii’s  
10 ADA Client Services Manager, Ms. Jeanine Pekkarinen. The new three-year plan, 2022-  
11 2024, retains the three primary goals – Membership, Community, and Advocacy – while  
12 calling out Operations as a fourth and critical goal.

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14 With the advent of the vaccine at the end of 2020, HDA spent much of 2021 facilitating  
15 Return to Work issues, vaccine distribution, inquiries, and concerns related to mandates,  
16 employment, and patient care. In addition, HDA worked closely with HiEMA to hold  
17 several PPE distributions events for Oahu members and non-members and coordinated  
18 with Kauai and Maui Dental Societies for their distributions. Hawaii Island’s PPE will  
19 be offered through a community partnership.

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21 Our HDA Journal continues to go out quarterly and in digital format only; there has been  
22 no concerns about this format from members that our office is aware of.

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24 The HDA and HDA Foundation have plans to update their operating agreement to auto  
25 renewal, starting in 2022. The basic fiscal management tasks of the Foundation will be  
26 handled by HDA staff starting in 2022.

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28 The HDA appreciates the continued support of the ADA State Public Affairs (SPA)  
29 grant, though HDA saw a slight drop in its grant request for August-December 2021.  
30 The grant dollars are a pass through to our firm, Hawaii Public Policy Advocates, and  
31 allows us to enhance our public relations work.
