21 22 23 24 25	The staff at HDA have received and responded to increased phone calls and emails from our membership related to the COVID-19 crisis. They have spent numerous hours in meetings with our Rapid Response Team and officials in the government to address the many concerns and questions forwarded by membership.
26 27 28	Honolulu County Dental Society and HDA have agreed to renew the annual operating agreement at \$60,000, for 2021 and beyond. The contract shall renew annually automatically unless either party elects not to.
29 30 31 32 33 34	The HDA continues to be successful in securing the State Public Affairs (SPA) grant from the ADA, for public relations/communications effort. The grant dollars are a pass through to our firm, Hawaii Public Policy Advocates, and allows us to enhance this work.
